Director's Update February 27th, 2020

This update reflects the changes in the *Ministry of Health's* protocol and their meeting with the Diplomatic Corps on February 27th, 2020 and superseded the Director's Update of 25th February.

The Croatian Government released updated instructions aimed at individuals who have traveled to any COVID-19 affected areas within the past 14 days. The affected areas include China, South Korea, Iran, Hong Kong, Japan, Singapore and Italy (currently counties of Veneto, Lombardy, Piemonte, Emilia-Romagna). Please note these affected areas may change.

Please note these important dates:

Arriving in Croatia from an affected area after February 24th

- Mandatory self quarantine for 14 days.
- Inform AISZ through the [Self Exclusion Declaration link](#) on the AISZ website.
- Contact family physician or [Regional Epidemiologist](#) for further instructions.

Arriving in Croatia from an affected area prior to February 24th

Self Monitoring

- Families and employees who have traveled to any COVID-19 affected areas prior to February 24th should self monitor their health and contact the [Regional epidemiologist](#), regardless of whether or not they have flu-like symptoms including cough, elevated temperature, or any other signs of respiratory illness.
- Report the recommendation to AISZ by emailing to medicalteam@aisz.hr.

Traveled to Affected Area in the Last 14 Days **AND have flu-like symptoms** (fever, chills, sore throat, cough, sore muscles or difficulties breathing)

- Students who have traveled to affected areas **and have flu-like symptoms**, must not come to school.
- Families must immediately contact their family physician or [Regional Epidemiologist](#) for further instructions.

Not Traveled to Affected Area in the Last 14 Days But **have flu-like symptoms**

- Families who **have not** traveled to COVID-19 affected areas within the past 14 days **but do have** flu-like symptoms or any other signs of respiratory illness should report to their family doctor.
- Remain at home until they are symptom-free for a period of at least 24 hours.

Please note this is standard school / medical protocol
